Eligibility

All artists and craftsmen over 18 years of age. For judged, exhibit-original work only -- **NO COPIES (a work is considered a copy if its subject matter has been copied from any other art work or published photograph; i.e. magazine photos, album covers, etc).** No work entered in previous **WAA art festivals will be eligible for awards.**

Media

Watercolor; oil/acrylic; mixed media; graphics; sculpture; photography; crafts; cyber art. All work **must be ready for hanging (with wire and screw eyes)**, and should not be larger than 40" x 40". We are sorry that we cannot accommodate the very large pieces of work because we do not have the capacity. (*there will be no exceptions*). **No Work will be accepted WET!!**

All work must be removed on Sunday, April 29, 2007 between 4:00 - 5:00pm - no earlier or no later. Work left after that time will be at owner's risk.

Hanging

Entries will be hung at the discretion of the display committee.

Sales

The Winthrop Art Association, Inc. charges a 20% commission on sales.

Judging

Work will be viewed and judged by two professional artists judges.

Prizes

First, second and third place ribbons will be awarded for outstanding work in each category at the discretion of the judges. There will also be a Town Council Award, and a Most Popular vote as well as several memorial awards. A special award in any medium, main subject must be **floral**. This award is in memory of Harold P. McCormick. There is a category called Cyber Art. Any form of art that has been computer enhanced/generated, refined or manipulated, including photography should be submitted in the category of Cyber Art.
