Festival Dates

Saturday, May 1st – Hours 12:00 – 6:00 PM
Sunday, 2nd – Hours 11:00 AM – 4 PM
Sunday – Reception/awards ceremony 2:00-4:00PM

Place

The Winthrop Senior Center, 35 Harvard St., Winthrop.

Eligibility

All artists and craftsmen must be 18 years of age and older. For judging, original artwork only – NO COPIES (work is considered a copy if its subject matter has been copied from any other art work or published photograph; i.e. magazine photos, etc). No work entered in previous WAA art festivals will be eligible.

Media

Watercolor; oil/acrylic; mixed media; graphics; photography; crafts; cyber art (any digitally or computer enhanced work; and sculpture. Recycled-Reborn Art, this consists of two or three-dimensional artwork using discarded or found objects. In order to enter this category your work has to be 75% recycled material.

All work must be ready for hanging (with wire and screw eyes, no saw-toothed hangers). If you do not have your work wired, there will be a charge of \$10 per piece by the committee to do it for you. Work cannot be larger than 40" X 40". We are sorry that we cannot accommodate the very large pieces of work because we do not have the capacity. (There will be no exceptions). No work will be accepted wet.

How To Apply

All work must be pre-registered by filling out the attached application form (right side stubs), detach and mail along with your registration fee.

Forms must be received by April 15th. Send to Dawn.

Fees

Members will be \$15 for 3 entries, non-members \$20 for 2 entries. All WAA members must be paid-up to date for 2008 in order to enter 3 pieces.

Drop-Off Dates

Friday, April 30th from 3:00 to 7:00 PM at the Winthrop Senior Center. Only work that has been pre-registered will be in the program. (Craft tables may be set-up after 7PM on Friday or 9:30 am to 12:00 pm on Saturday.)

Removal

All work must be removed on Sunday, May 2nd between 4:00 – 5:00 PM. No earlier or later please. Work left after that time will be at the owner's risk. Work not picked up will be subject to a \$2.00 per day storage fee.

Hanging

Entries will be hung at the discretion of the display chairperson and committee. The medium must be put on the back of every entry so your work will not be put in the wrong section.

Judging

Work will be viewed and judged by two professional artist judges. The WAA has nothing to do with their choices.

Prizes

A \$25 first prize then second and third place ribbons will be awarded for outstanding work in each category at the discretion of the judges. There will also be a Town Council Award and a Most Popular vote as well as several memorial awards. Memorial Awards are funded by families named. A special award in any medium, the main subject must be floral in memory of Harold P. McCormick. There is a category called Cyber Art. Any form of art that has been computer enhanced/generated, refined or manipulated work should be submitted in the category of Cyber Art.

Entries to the festival will be handled with all possible care; however, the Winthrop Art Association assumes no responsibility for damages or loss.
