Eligibility

All artists and craftsmen must be 18 years of age or older. For Judging, original artwork only – NO COPIES (work is considered a copy if its subject matter has been copied from any other art work or published photograph; i.e. magazine photos, etc.). No work entered in previous WAA art festivals will be eligible.

Media

Watercolor; oil; acrylics; Mixed media; graphics; photography; crafts; cyber art (art digitally or computer enhanced work; and recycled-reborn art,) (this consists of two or three-dimensional artwork using discarded or found objects). In order to enter this category your work has to be 75% recycled material.

All work must be ready for hanging with wire and screw eyes, (no saw-toothed hangers). If you do not have your work wired, there will be a charge of \$10 per piece by the committee to do it for you. Work cannot be larger than 50” in either direction. There will be no exceptions. No work will be accepted wet.

How To Apply

All work must be pre-registered by filling out the attached application form (right side stubs), detach and mail along with your registration fee.

Forms must be received by April 15th

Fees

Members will pay \$20 for 3 entries and non-members pay \$25 for 2 entries. All WAA members must be paid-up to date for 2017-2018; in order to enter 3 pieces.

Drop-Off Dates

Wednesday, April 25th from 3 to 7 PM at E.B. Newton Cultural Center. Only work that has been pre-registered will be in the program or accepted at the door. (Craft tables may be set-up on Saturday morning at 10am.)

Removal

All work **must** be removed on Sunday, April 29th, 4pm to 5pm unless you are leaving it for the great hall exhibit. No earlier or later please. Work left after that time will be at the owner’s risk. Work not picked up will be subject to a \$5 per day storage fee.

Hanging

Entries will be hung at the discretion of the display-chairperson and committee. Please put the stubs with the medium on the back, upper right hand corner of every entry so your work will not be put in the wrong section. If it is not put on the entry we will not be able to hang your work.

Prizes

A \$25 first prize, and ribbons will be awarded for work in each category at the discretion of the judges. There are several memorial awards. The individual families fund the memorial awards. A special award is given in any medium, with a floral subject in memory of Harold P. McCormick.

Entries to the festival will be handled with all possible care; however, the Winthrop Art Association assumes no responsibility for damages or loss.
